1. Summary

The EMCJ of IEICE had several regular technical meetings every year and IEEJ-EMC had two technical meetings in the period of October 2016 to February 2017, nine regular technical meetings in the period of September 2017 to June 2018, 6 regular technical meetings in the period of July 2018 to March 2019, and 10 regular technical meetings in the period of September 2020 to July 2021.
